School Plan

School Year- First Day August 31

School will be divided into two groups- Green and Gold

Students will attend school on their color assigned day.

What does school look like?

7th/8th Will enter the building through the South gate and cafeteria. Start: 8:00 am

5th/6th Will enter the building through the glass foyer to the gym. Start: 8:05 am

Breakfast will be served to both groups.

Students will report immediately to First Period Classes

No Lockers - Students will use backpacks

What does school look like?

5th/6th- 4 classes each day- Math, English, Science, Social Studies

7th/8th- 4 classes each day- Math, English, Science/Social Studies,
Computers/Health

Schools PLP Curriculum

Class time- Work on lessons- ask questions of teachers- take quizzes and tests

Home time- Work on lessons- email questions to teachers

What does school look like?

Project Based Learning- Communication, Collaboration, Creativity, Critical Thinking

Monthly projects in classes- will usually be a group project- but can be individual

Will require completion of project parts outside of school- students can work on PBL while at school if they are caught up on Schools PLP classes.

What does school look like?

Core classes and lunch- 8:00-1:00

What happens at 1:00?

IF ALL SCHOOLS PLP CLASSWORK IS UP TO DATE AND PASSING:

STUDENTS CAN:

- Use extra time to complete lessons/tests/quizzes, get help from teachers, work on PBL
- Go home with written permission from parents on file in office.

What does school look like?

IF SCHOOL PLP CLASSWORK IS NOT UP TO DATE AND/OR NOT PASSING

STUDENTS WILL:

- Be assigned immediate intervention that day for the class(es) that they need help in

What does school look like?

Can my student go ahead in their Schools PLP classes?

- YES- we will keep track of them and if they are breezing through, we will give them some extra activities to deepen their learning. If they finish early- we will move them on to the next level class for that subject.

What happens if my student falls behind?

- There will be a pacing guide that shows the student where they need to be to be on pace to finish- If they get behind- we have the flexibility to keep some kids 4 days a week to get them back on track.

What does school look like?

What and where does Lunch look like?

- Lunch will be served each day at school. We will social distance at the lunch tables and the outside tables. Students can also eat on the grass if they choose- as long as trash get picked up every day.
- Lunch will probably consist of one entree and a sack lunch with individually packaged items in it.

Will my student's temperature be taken?

- Yes- on an as needed basis. This is normally be done by the school nurse.

What does school look like?

When are masks required?

- As of now- masks are required all day except when eating or in strenuous exercise.

Who will clean the desks in between classes?

- Students will grab a wipe as they enter each class and wipe down their desk area before sitting in it.

What does school look like?

What if my student has to miss a day of school? Can they come on a different day to make it up?

- We are working on a solution where if you know your child will be gone on their assigned day, you can contact the office to have them come on a different day so they still get the facetime with teachers. There will be a limited number of spaces available for this and you will only be able to utilize this option a few times during the school year.

What does school look like?

What if my child is sick? Has a temp? Cough? Sore Throat? Etc?

- Please keep your child home if they exhibit any symptoms of sickness. They will not miss out on any school work as they can continue to work online from home.

What happens if the school is forced to shut down?

- With School PLP- we will be able to continue classes as usual. Teachers will have daily Google Meet classes where students can get direct help and take quizzes and tests.

What does school look like?

What happens to extra activities? Sports? Clubs?

- As of now- all activities are on hold and being reviewed on a case by case basis. If a regular sports season cannot be held- the school will attempt to offer some sort of intramural sports opportunity for our students.

Will we ever get to all kids attending everyday?

- We hope so. With 3 foot social distancing- we can fit the kids in our school- but we want to make sure that we are ready for all situations as we do not know what the year will bring- As soon as it is safe and our educational plan is practiced and established- we will try to get back to all kids at school every day.
